2026 SEELEY LAKE SUMMER MARKET VENDOR GUIDELINES

All vendors and volunteers are to act in a professional manner.

The entire Seeley Lake Summer Market area and grounds are a NO SMOKING ZONE.

Designated smoking areas are available off-site at least 10" from market area.

PETS: No animals are allowed within 15 feet of any food vendor. **This is a Missoula County regulation that we must comply with and is non-negotiable.** Thank you for your understanding.

ONLY EXCEPTION: Service animals as required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.

SETUP: 7:30 AM – 9:00 AM. Please do not arrive earlier than 7:30 am or later than 8:30 am.

TAKEDOWN: 1:00 PM. Vehicles will not be allowed to enter the Market perimeter prior to 1:00.

No vehicles are allowed on the grass at any time – including loading or unloading product.

Your courtesy is appreciated in making the Seeley Lake Summer Market a success for all!

Mission Statement: "To strengthen the Seeley Lake community by providing a place for local vendors to thrive, offering residents and visitors a diverse selection of fresh produce, local Montana artisan goods, and unique experiences, while fostering a sense of shared pride and connection to Seeley Lake."

REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL VENDORS

- Complete the 2026 Application Form and provide booth rental payment.
- Dress appropriately, including wearing shirts and shoes, always.
- Provide your own method for accepting credit cards (if desired).
- Ensure your booth is occupied during market hours from 9:00 am - 1:00 pm.
- Maintain and leave a clean area, including removing all trash or debris generated by the sale of your product. Vendors need to provide containers suitable for waste removal.
- Provide your own tables, signs, display materials and canopies or booth covers.

MANDATORY REQUIREMENT: ALL canopies or booth covers must be flame retardant & have adequate weights (25 lbs minimum) attached to each of the 4 legs. No stakes are allowed.

- Display a sign identifying the business or organization by name.
- Vendors may not share a booth.
- Vendors who do not show by 9:00 am Sunday or cancel after 5:00 pm the preceding Friday, will lose their space and forfeit their fee.

Vendors may drive to the market area perimeter with their vehicle for the purpose of unloading only. After unloading, please move your vehicle before setting up your booth. Offsite Special Vendor parking will be available in the Seeley Lake School parking lot (on School Lane just north of the Market).

BOOTH AREAS

- Vendors will be assigned a 10' x 10' booth area. Vendor locations are determined by the Market Manager, taking into consideration market appearance, customer flow and product diversity.
- Vendors should mark on application if requesting a booth with an electrical outlet.
- Music played in booths must have prior approval from the Market Manager.

FEES

- \$25.00 – Single Booth
- \$35.00 – Foods Trucks
- \$350.00 (Food Trucks \$510) Season Pass will reserve you a designated space for all 16 markets (\$50 savings). This fee is non-refundable and must be paid by April 15, 2026.
- No cost for information booth (if raffle tickets are sold \$25 booth charge will apply)
- No cost to youth vendors (under the age of 16)

REQUIREMENT: Vendors planning to attend the first market on May 24th need to pay in advance to ensure a booth for Memorial Day opening weekend.

Both cash and check payments are accepted. Please make checks payable to Uff Da Montana Enterprises, LLC.

Arts & Crafts Vendors

Vendors who handcraft in the Seeley-Swan Valley and products Made in Montana will be given priority consideration.

Food & Agriculture Product Vendors

Food vendors must attach current Licenses, Certificates, and Proof of Insurance to their application, showing Uff Da Montana Enterprises, LLC as additional insured.
